EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION

Ms. Mead introduced Mr. Ed Liegl from Meridian School District. Mr. Liegl gave a presentation on the tour students (19) from Stillman Valley High School participated in to Swedish American Hospital. A representative from the hospital spoke to the students prior to the tour to discuss expectations and other policies, then upon arrival at the hospital, the group was split into two groups who were able to review separate areas of the building. SYSTEM DIRECTORS REPORT

Region co-horts with RPS were briefly discussed, currently, they are only interested in getting Master's programs for their Biology teachers organized.

Ms. Cooper from RVC presented the current and possible future Dual Credit and Articulated Credit classes being offered with RVC and region schools. South Beloit asked if any other schools had college professors teaching the classes in the high school as they do, none do at this time.

Hononegah would like to see a group of region teachers get together so that a Master's program could be offered locally, RPS agreed as they are trying to organize. RPS also believes it's in the region's best interest to urge faculty to earn their 1st Master's Degree in their content area rather than what is easiest to obtain, it was discussed this would be a part of collective bargaining in each district.

CEP have 2 new offerings for FY20, they will be Sports Medicine in Winnebago, and Entrepreneurship in Hononegah. Harlem would like a presentation on the Hononegah Incubator program to educate the board on what they have to offer.

Policy Sub Committee will next meet January 25, 12:00 noon at Hononegah District Office. The committee will now be working on updating the IGA as it has not been reviewed since the 80's. Anyone interested in participating in the IGA discussions is welcome to attend the meeting. Mr. Scott Bloomquist from the Regional Office will also be involved in this process.
