

MEDICAL SCIENCE EXPECTATIONS

Each candidate for the Medical Science program must provide 2 letters of recommendation with their application; use the form that is provided on the CEANCI.org website – Counselor page.

In order to participate in the Medical-Science class, the following prerequisites must be in place by the beginning of the school year:

1-Each student is required to get a release by a physician stating they have no medical restrictions in order to properly carry out the required nursing assistant tasks. This would include transporting patients under supervision of the instructor. The Medical-Release form is enclosed and should be signed by the physician and returned to me on the first day of class.

2-A two-step, tuberculosis Mantoux skin tests must be administered with results of each skin test recorded again, returned to me one the first day of class.

3-All students must be up-to-date on required immunizations. I will contact each school regarding the status of each student's immunization records.

4-As of last year, every student will be required to have a "flu" shot. I will have more information on the influenza vaccine on the first day of class.

5-Proof of the chickenpox vaccine or documentation from a physician stating the student has had chickenpox.

The uniform will be discussed on the first day of class as well as other important information.
