Depending on your ability to commit time and resources, we have outlined some common WBL activities in which we need your support.

SHORT-TERM ACTIVITIES

CAREER COACH

1+ hrs/week
Respond to student
questions and offer advice
via a web discussion board.

GUEST SPEAKER

30-60 minutes (per class)Speak to a group of students & teachers about your career, training and skills, or

career, training and skills, or about general business topics.

COMPANY TOUR

1-2 hours

Tours allow classes of students and/or teachers to view an organization's facility and operations.

MOCK / INFORMATIONAL INTERVIEW

15–60 min. per interview Help students develop their interviewing skills and provide constructive feedback.

BUSINESS ROUND TABLE

4 hours

Experts discuss trends and industry standards.

JOB SHADOW

2-8 hours

Allow students to observe daily routines and activities of your job.

COMPETITION JUDGE

1 -8 hours

Help judge student projects and provide constructive feedback.

CAREER FAIR

2-8 hours

Participate in a career fair by having a booth or by meeting with a small group of students/job seekers as they explore their career options.

JOB 24+ hrs

Provide students valuable work experience.

CURRICULUM ADVISOR 1-15 hours

Teachers consult with industry experts about industry trends in order to begin aligning high school curriculum.

SUMMER SITE VISIT-TEACHERS

2-4 hours

Teachers visit business sites to learn daily routines and activities of a company.

COMMITTEE MEMBER

1-40 hours

Participate in a variety of workforce development and education preparatory committees.

24+ hours

Monthly meetings to provide recommendations on building academies.
